Piopio Primary and the Piopio Youth Sports Committee are here to ensure that sport is enjoyed by all, in a safe, positive environment. Please remember that sport is a time for students to develop their technical, tactical and social skills. Winning is an important part of sport, but isn't everything. We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in sport, please play your part by accepting and agreeing to this parent code of conduct/behaviour at all times.

As a parent/supporter for Piopio primary school I will always;

- Provide encouragement and support by praising efforts, performance and results in a positive manner.
- Remember that students play sports for FUN and for their satisfaction not yours.
- Encourage fair play on and off the field of play, applaud the performance of both teams.
- Be positive with the officials and coaches and remember that they are volunteers.
- Remain outside the field of play and within the designated spectators area.
- Display self-control on the sideline and let the coach do their job
- Always respect the match officials, referee and opposition and encourage players to do the same.
- Show appreciation to coaches and officials who facilitate the game and acknowledge their efforts.
- Never criticise a player for making a mistake- mistakes are part of learning.
- Use appropriate language. Never engage in , or tolerate, offensive or abusive language.

I understand that if I do not follow this code of conduct/behaviour, any/all of the following actions may be taken;

I may be;

- Asked to leave the game/training by the coach or an official.
- Issued with a verbal warning from the school.
- Required to meet with the school sports coordinator and/or school principal.
- Requested by the school not to attend future games/training.
