Before School Expectations

Students will

- -Take their shoes off when coming inside and leave them under their bags
- -Hang up their school bag on their hook
- -Put their homework journal in the homework box
- -Put their book bag into the container
- -Can choose to play inside or outside before the learning bell Your help to remind them about these routines would be greatly appreciated

Clothing

- -Please insure that your childs clothing is named.
- -The expectation is that when students take something off, they put it in their school bag.
- -It is also expected that students have a **change** of clothes and a bag to put them into at school.
- -Please discourage your child from wearing gumboots to school in Terms 1 and 4

Library

- -Library day is usually Thursday (room 9) Friday (room 1 and 2)
- -Students are issued with two books to take home to enjoy for a week
- -Students must transport library books in their book bag to keep them safe.
- -Please ensure your child returns their books on or before library day so they can be issued with new books

Relievers

- -Where possible I will use the same reliever in class to ensure continuity.
- -When a reliever is in our class, the expectations remain the same.

Buses and pick up

Rainy days

- -If it is raining at playtime or lunchtime, children eat inside.
- -All classes are supervised by room 5/6 students and a roaming duty teacher.

Literacy

- -Instructional reading in groups is taken Monday through to Thursday.
- -Letter sound mats/books will be recorded in their home journal.
- -Please take time to discuss homework with your child everyday and record a positive comment
- -Please ensure homework journals are returned each day along with any literary work.
- -The journals have a built in rewards system with every 25 night of home learning.
- -Please ensure the home journals are returned each day in the same condition they were sent home in.

Numeracy

Students in our class will work in groups. These will begin once assessments are complete.

Number continues as a major focus. Please encourage plenty of regular practise of number recognition so they are instantly recalled.

 On occasion Room 2 may have a weekly numeracy based worksheet.

Red Flags

When the red flags are out on the playground it signals the children may only play on the concrete areas or tiger turf due to rain or wet/muddy underfoot conditions.

Health and Physical Education

- -Children are asked to play in the shade if they do not have suitable protection from the sun.
- -There is sunscreen available in class or children are very welcome to bring their own.

Writing

Writing samples are taken on a regular basis. These samples are assessed to provide information for learning needs and future teaching.

Language experiences will occur regularly to develop the children's motivation to write and develop/utilise their word knowledge
