# COMMUNICATION


Please do not hesitate to Contact us at school if you have any queries or concerns.

# Welcome to Room 7 GETTING READY FOR THE DAY

Students need to:

Arrive at school no earlier than 8.15am

- © Take their shoes off before coming inside and leave them on the floor beneath their bag.
- © Hang their school bag up on their top hook.
- © Put their reading journal in the reading box.
- © Put their homework wallet in their tote tray.
- © Check that they have a sharp pencil and have their learning tools on their table.
- © Go and play outside if it is fine. If it is wet they may stay inside and play.

## **CLOTHING**

- $\odot$  Please ensure that your child's clothing is named.
- O The expectation is that when students take something off, they put it in their school bag.
- ☺ It is also expected that students have a change of clothes with them at school.
- © Please discourage your child from wearing gumboots to school in Terms 1 and 4.

# LIBRARY

- $\ensuremath{\boxdot}$  Library day is usually a Monday.
- © Students are issued with two books to take home to enjoy for a week.
- © Students must transport library books in their book bag to keep them safe.
- © Please ensure your child returns their books on or before the library day so they can be issued with new books.

#### **RED FLAGS**

- © When the red flags are out in the playground it signals students may only play on the concrete and astro-turf areas due to rain or wet/muddy underfoot conditions.
- If they have a sports practice and the flags are out, they may go to practice if they have a change of clothes.

#### **RAINY DAYS**

- ☺ If it is raining at playtime or lunchtime, students eat inside supervised by their teacher.
- © At lunchtimes on rainy days there is an organized programme in the senior block supervised by teachers.

#### SPORTS PRACTISES

© Children must eat their lunch in the normal designated area before they go to lunchtime practices.

#### SUNSMART

- S As per our Sunsmart Policy, it is a requirement that all students have a bucket hat that provides cover for their ears, face and neck.
- © Students are asked to play in the shade if they do not have suitable protection from the sun.
- © There is sunscreen available in class or children are very welcome to bring their own.

#### **HEĂLTH & PHYSED**

- © Term1: Swimming– Please ensure your child has their togs and a towel in a waterproof bag everyday.
- © Term 1 to 4 Please ensure your child wears/brings suitable clothes for physical activities and training.
- ☺ As physical activities are part of the school curriculum, a note is required if your child is unable to take part.
- C Tissues and hand sanitizer are available in classrooms and your child is welcome to bring their own to use.
- © Students are welcome to wear a mask if they want to.

## LITERACY

- © Room 7 students are expected to **choose their own** home reading material, read every night and
- record a comment/reflection about what they have read. © Please ensure home reading journals are returned each
- Friday and Monday with date, book title, student comment and adult signature.
- © The journals have a built-in reward system with every 25 nights of home reading recognised. Dojo points are given when journals are brought back to school.
- Principal's Awards will be presented at the end of the year for 200 + nights of home reading.

# WORD KNOWLEDGE/SPELLING

- © Your child will be tested on their sound/blend and word knowledge. This will be the basis for their school spelling and also guides the classroom programme.
- $\ensuremath{\textcircled{}}$  There will be no spelling homework sent home.

#### NUMERACY

- © Students in our class will work in ability groups. These will begin once assessments are complete.
- Showledge and strategy will be 60-80% of our focus. Please encourage plenty of regular practise of number knowledge and basic facts at home.
- © A laminated multiplication poster will be sent home with your child to support their learning.

#### RELIEVERS

© When a reliever is in our class, the behaviour and learning expectations remain the same.

## HOMEWORK

- © We encourage you to read with your child every night and take time to discuss the book. Please record a positive comment in their reading journal.
- © Maths homework will usually be sent home on Mondays and is due back each Friday.
